4. If in school you should maintain good grades and have good attendance. You must also provide a progress report stating your behavior and grades.

6. You must respect other riders and track rules at all times! Good sportsmanship is a must!
7. No fighting, physical or verbal! No profanity or “trash” talk to or about other riders!
8. No using tobacco products, drugs or alcohol!
9. No clothing or stickers, etc with controversial sayings or symbols.
10. You must participate in fundraisers.
11. You must volunteer at least ten hours a year at your local track
12. Your uniform should be neat, clean and with no holes or tears
13. Bikes should be clean, properly maintained and in good working order.
14. You must use and promote our sponsors as much as possible during events!
